

Dear Head Teacher

What an unusual start to the terms this year. Last term started with snow and this term with ash! We are busy as always, despite the general election looming. Can I confirm that monies for the continuation of the School Sport Partnership are guaranteed until 2011. This is the last term for the new partnership to spend lottery money, and next academic year, as a partnership, we will have £17,500 to support school sport coaching. All monies are to help you achieve the 5 hour offer for our children.

LOOKING BACK TO LAST TERM :

The PLT conference had workshops focusing on:

1. Teaching observations to help improve the teaching and learning for pupils
2. Gifted and Talented workshop to help identify the G&T pupils in your school and to start the process of how you can support them
3. The Key Steps Gymnastic framework as a suggestion for intra competition
4. Curriculum mapping, with links across the new curriculum
5. School club links workshop, with thoughts on how we can link and make stronger links and more formal links with our local facilities.
6. All paperwork connected with employment of coaches, making sure we comply with safeguarding legislation.

The School Club Links evening to help our community understand the 5 hour offer and hopefully how we can work together to support each others aims.

The Partnership Festivals.....Primary Dance Festival, attended by 18 schools and 400 children, Senior Dance Festival, attended by 5 schools and 100 children, Primary Gym Festival attended by 12 schools and 200 children, Primary Gym Key Steps Competition attended by 12 schools and 100 children,

Netball International 100 children from 8 schools went to the O2 to see England just narrowly beaten by Australia

Partnership Clubs as schools own facilities have become fuller this term we have run family and partnership clubs at 3 secondary schools, DCHS , Amersham and Chesham Park. The sports have been dance, gymnastics, hockey, football, netball and trampolining and have been very popular free clubs paid for out of the school sport coaching grant and by SSCOs generosity.

The Young Ambassadors , one from each secondary school, finished off their year with a fantastic badminton tournament organized at St Mary's school. They have now passed on their role to new ambassadors. Their challenge is to promote the Olympic ideals in schools. I wonder if primary schools would also consider having a young ambassador for sport in their school? They could take an active part in supporting you

in your plans for National School Sport week. We have also offered How to Coach safely for young volunteers across the partnership

NEWS FOR THIS TERM :

Annual Data Collection

This term we look forward to the annual data collection in order to prove that we collectively are making a difference. All schools who are on Bucks GFL have been offered the opportunity to get the children to answer the questions on line, which saves an enormous amount of time for the PLT/SSCO when collating data and ongoing targeted work for the children who aren't making the 5 hours. Not everyone can access this and also some staff feel that KS1 children may be too young. So as always schools will be asked to complete in paper for a questionnaire that will enable us to collate and answer the questions the government department ask us to. These questionnaires will be sent out next week and the results need to come to the workshop at Bell Lane School on May 20th at 9.00am. it is part of the Partnership agreement that all schools complete this, but also I am assured that this data will be used to award Activemark and Sportsmark this year. I hope I am reliably informed.
